Course content

- Measuring performance

Assessment

Upon completion of the three-day course, candidates will sit a short examination and will submit a risk assessment project which they will work on throughout the course in the classroom. Successful candidates will be presented with an IOSH certificate, which will be forwarded from IOSH in due course.
